## To Our Supporters,

It is regrettable. We are disappointed. You are disappointed. We will miss everyone this year; the performers, artists, vendors, volunteers, sponsors, and of course our guests and visitors. Rest assured, this is not goodbye; Almonte Celtfest will be back for our 25th anniversary in July 2021 with an even bigger and bolder festival and we cannot wait to celebrate with you.

As for Celtfest 2020, the festival may be cancelled but we are still here. We will have you back when we feel it is appropriately safe to gather everyone together again. In the meantime, please be sure to stay tuned for information on potential alternative digital programming, other ways to engage while we ride this out, and check out our "Celtfest Gives Back" project on our website and social media accounts to find out how you can support local and stay involved or how we can support your business during these tough times. This project mirrors our past sponsorship, vendor and partner packages but is completely free for the 2020 to enable us to help our friends and neighbours in whatever way they need at this time.
